

The UN Office at Geneva has mapped out the expertise on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) found across international organizations, NGOs and other institutions based in Geneva.

This has been envisioned as a tool to strengthen partnerships and improve coordination. The goal is to provide a clear overview of “who is doing what and where”, to contribute towards achieving the SDGs.

For each goal, participating international actors assessed their expertise in terms of
